Do we understand this concept and opportunity in Clinical Science, Social Science, Law? It's a burning question? Answers are needed to help better understanding especially for Emergency Ambulance Services; Police Service at Emergency Events; Council Social Services. Hypoglycaemia with Low Blood Glucose associated with Neuroglycopenia and rapid lowering of Blood Glucose below 4.0mmol/l can be alarming. It is a Red Alert Clinical Emergency when 'immediate witness attention and action is required to prevent Coma and if not corrected exposure to Fatal Outcome if BG falls below 1.5 - 2.0mmol/l. Let's Share the Knowledge for future generations to benefit.
