



## Editorial Note for Journal of Molecular Histology and Medical Physiology

I am pleased to mention that during the year 2019, all issues of Volume 5 were published online well within the time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online.

JMHMP also about to bring out a supplement to upcoming Mar-Nov 2020 volumes, which having estimates consisted of more than 50 articles abstracts in the field of physical chemistry, Physiology of Cell, Cancer Cell, Cytology, Chromogenchemical biology, or biochemistry, but also allied disciplines such as systems biology, RNA biology, microbiology, neurobiology, epigenetic, computational biology, Chemical composition of living matter, Applied biochemistry, Biochemical reactions, Genetics, Plant biochemistry, Amino acids & protein sequence, Protein structure & function, Enzyme kinetics, Coenzymes, Lipids & membranes.

The JCR Impact factor of JMHMP for the year 2018 was 0.03, while the current SJR index dropped to 0.016. The H-index of the journal, however, increased to 5. JMHMP is also indexed among the RefSeek, Hamdard University, EBSCO A-Z, Publons. Apart from this the JMHMP employs the use of various social networking platforms like twitter, linkedin as well as a newly developed advertisement option on the Journal homepage to advertise and disperse the information related to the journal content including conferences, special issues and articles recently published. The communication between the journal coordinators and authors is well maintained through telephonic conversations, e-mailing and whatsapp to keep the authors, reviewers and editors on the same page. JMHMP follows a double blind peer review process and the data base of reviewers and editors is composed of eminent

researchers around the world whose contribution to the scientific world is impeccable.

During the calendar year 2019, JMHMP received a total of 10 papers, out of which 7 articles (80%) were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format. During 2019 around 3 articles were subjected to the peer-review process and 3 of those were accepted. In the 1 issues of Volume 4 published during the year 2019, a total of 04 articles were published of which, 70% articles were by foreign authors. A total of more than 50 research scientists from India and JMHMP reviewed the 50 articles published in all 4 Volumes. Average publication time of an article is 4-5 weeks depending upon the authors to submit their revisions on time.

During the calendar year 2019, a total 2 Editors, 5 Reviewers joined the board of JMHMP and contributed their invaluable services towards contribution as well as publication of articles.

I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of Quality check team during the final editing of articles published and the support rendered by the Editor-in-Chief George Perry, and editorial board member Jean-Marie Exbrayat bringing out issues of JMHMP in time. I would also like to express my gratitude to all the authors, reviewers, the publisher, the advisory and the editorial board of JMHMP, the office bearers and staff of Hilaris Publishing for their support in bringing out yet another volume of JMHMP and look forward to their unrelenting support to bring out the Volume 5 of JMHMP in scheduled time.
